The Sanctuary is a brand new bright, colourful modern flexible space for students to use all year round with 180 study seats.


It is located right at the centre of campus under the Great Hall, adjacent to the Forum.

Meet the Customer - Exeter College


Customer Exeter College is celebrating after being judged as 'outstanding' in the first no-notice OFSTED inspection of a FE college.

We have been working with the college on a project over the last few months, supplying and fitting wallboards and graphics to various locations including above the main entrance to the College's Centre for Creative Industries.


Chelle Perry of Exeter College commented: "The images we've put around the College with Signs Express have given our buildings real identity and give our students and visitors
